On March 10th, Rodriguez Elementary held their Family Fitness Night. Students and their families were invited to participate in fun physical activities, eat healthy snacks, and receive information on healthy lifestyles. The Rodriguez Coordinated School Health Team

planned and organized the event and promoted it through their Student Wellness Team, stickers, flyers, and robocalls home. Approximately 125 students and family members attended the event, and several individuals walked away with prizes that promote physical activity at home!

Brighter Bites

On Friday, March 11, Brighter Bites successfully completed their first spring cycle and full pilot year of programming in the GAVA elementary schools. Over the course of the spring session, 1531 families from Pre-K through 5th grades enrolled in the program. During this time, Brighter Bites staff and volunteers sorted and delivered 349,572 pounds of produce to families, volunteers, and Pre-K through 5th grade teachers, many of whom used the produce in their classrooms for nutrition education lessons. That is a lot of fruits and veggies! Brighter Bites staff are incredibly grateful to the faculty, volunteer, and community support of its programming this school year.
