#### **Park Funding Wins!**

The park & creek adoption teams who make up GAVA's the Physical Activity (P.A.) Sector) continued their advocacy work for \$1.15M funds available through the Park Block Grant. In In February, the resident team leaders met regularly with Austin's Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) about the



funds and toured area parks. They also testified in front of the Open Space Committee of City Council. The GAVA teams have been dedicated and tireless in their work to secure public, private and in-kind funding to improve their green spaces. Their hard work has resulted in a

commitment from both the City and PARD to explore funding opportunities for issues such as lighting and track improvements in the next budget cycle, and a commitment from the Austin Parks Foundation to work toward installation of fitness equipment at multiple parks. Congratulations to all teams for all that you have accomplished!
