City Budget: Austin Interfaith leaders and GAVA residents spoke in person and by video at the 9/1 city budget hearing calling on the council to fund \$500,000 for parks lighting and \$147,000 for healthy corner store incentives, as well as additional funds to support neighborhood farm stands. Council members were supportive but faced a highly limited budget, and on September 14th made final votes to allocate partial funding for each initiative.
